The Roosevelt Boyd Memorial Scholarship was created to honor the life, the work and the legacy of the late Roosevelt Boyd, Founder of Greater Progressive Temple of Faith Church. Roosevelt Boyd established Progressive Temple of Faith, a church on the move and a people who love everybody in September of 1984. From the inception of his role of leader and pastor of this church, Pastor Boyd made an impact through service and leadership in the city of Anderson.

Progressive Temple of Faith is committed to helping young people succeed. This includes ensuring that students have access to the financial resources they need to obtain a college education which brings about the establishment of the Roosevelt Boyd Memorial Scholarship Reverend Roosevelt Boyd was a leader, a shepherd, a teacher, a father, a friend, and a mentor. From his days as bus driver #8 to He was one of the first Pastors in the city of Anderson that gave youth a platform to serve and use their gifts in the church. The youth were the cornerstone of his heart and the ministry for the church. Through his ministry Pastor Boyd has always supported and been an advocate for different activities that benefitted the youth and the community.

The goal of the Roosevelt Boyd Memorial Scholarship is to alleviate the cost of pursuing a higher education for students in the Anderson community. The scholarship will help students pay for their college degree in which otherwise they may not have access to. We hope to make impact in the lives of the recipients of the scholarship by filling in the financial gap for some families.

Eligibility for High School Seniors:

Scholarships are open to all high school seniors who have been accepted for admission and will be attending an accredited college or university by the fall semester of 2024. Scholarships are available to students attending high school within the city of Anderson, Indiana. To be eligible to apply, students **must have** a grade point average of at least a 2.5 (based on a 4.0 scale) and enroll in a full-time program at an accredited college or university during the 2024-2025 academic year. The funds will be disbursed directly to the college or university that the recipient enrolls in. Proof of enrollment must be provided before the funds will be dispersed. Academic achievement, community involvement, leadership positions, sports and other extracurricular activities will be considered. **You do not have to be affiliated with Progressive Temple of Faith Church in any way to win a scholarship. All gender identities are welcome to apply**.

Eligibility for Current Undergraduate College Students:

Scholarships are open to current college students **who have at least one full year left of undergraduate coursework to complete prior to graduation.** Applicants must be currently attending an accredited college or university. Scholarships are available to students whose home residence/ address is in the city of Anderson, Indiana. To be eligible to apply, students **must have** a grade point average of at least a 2.5 (based on a 4.0 scale) and be enrolled in a fulltime program at an accredited college or university during the 2024-2025 academic year. The funds will be disbursed directly to the college or university that the recipient enrolls in. Proof of enrollment must be provided before the funds will be dispersed. Academic achievement, community involvement, leadership positions, sports and other extracurricular activities will be considered. You do not have to be affiliated with Progressive Temple of Faith Church in any way to win a scholarship. All gender identities are welcome to apply.

Scholarship Basics:

<u>Scholarship Amount</u>: Two (2) **\$2,000 will be awarded.** One will be awarded to a <u>graduating</u> <u>high school senior</u> and one to a <u>current undergraduate college student</u>. There will also be two **\$500** <u>book scholarships</u> awarded to two additional students.

<u>Application Deadline</u>: March 4, 2024 – Completed application must be received by this date.

**Winners will be notified via email by April 7th, 2024.

Applications must include the following items:

- A completed application form with required signature(s)
- An official, signed and/or embossed seal transcript or the official electronic equivalent from the school
- One letter of recommendation
- A typed essay (max 1200 words) in response to the topic question
- Proof of residency in the city of Anderson
- A signature from a parent or guardian (if under 18 years old)
